

Aim


Ensure FAIRNESS in the allocation of data value among the actors of the data economy

Tackle imbalances caused by the MARKET POWER of gatekeepers



What and why EDIC



EDIC for mobility data can support common infrastructure and ensure long-term sustainability



EDIC can facilitate coordination and continuity between different projects at the European and national levels



Possible **activities of EDIC for mobility data** include providing infrastructure and services, interoperability certification, consolidating technical infrastructures, and proposing scaling activities and strategies

Digital Infrastructure Logistics

- The Dutch government has funded a special program to create a Basis Datasharing Infrastructure ("Digital Infrastructure for Logistics") in the Netherlands
- This program finds its basis in the European Data Strategy and ambitions for a Mobility Data Space:
 - Realise interoperability between all parties in (international) logistics processes
 - Based on federative data sharing, mutual agreed standards
