What is the Urban Logistics Disaster Plan?

The Urban Logistics Disaster Plan is a decision-support framework that helps cities prepare for and respond to emergencies affecting urban logistics. It enables public authorities and logistics operators to coordinate critical freight operations, identify priority delivery needs, and allocate available resources during disruptive events such as floods, earthquakes, or other crises.

By combining logistics planning with real-time information, the plan improves the resilience of urban supply chains, helping ensure the continuity of essential deliveries while supporting faster and more coordinated emergency response.

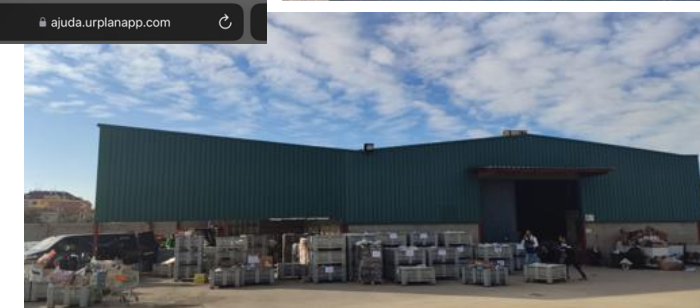


Value Drivers:

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The Pilot testing in Valencia, Spain

The solution provides a structured methodology and digital platform to coordinate urban emergency logistics during disasters. It enables public authorities, humanitarian organizations, and logistics operators to share information, allocate resources, and manage emergency operations in real time.

The pilot, validated during the 2024 DANA floods, demonstrated that coordinated emergency logistics can improve preparedness, accelerate response times, optimize resource allocation, and strengthen the resilience of cities facing natural disasters.
