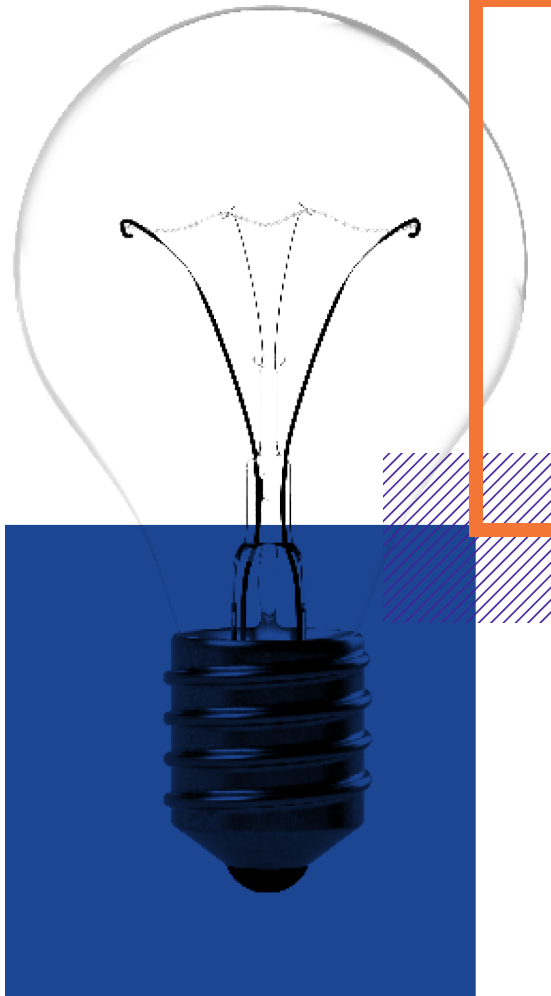

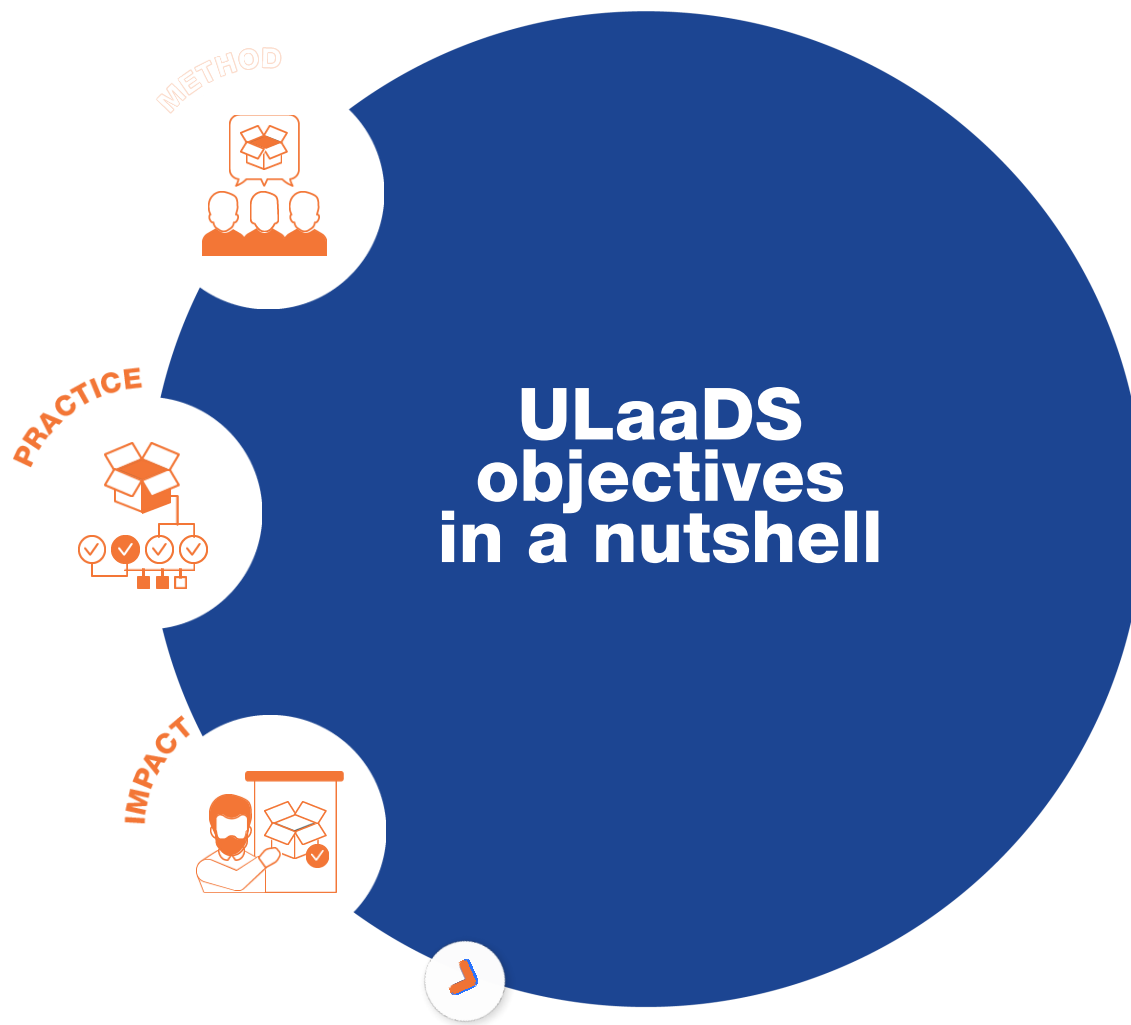

Vision and Objectives

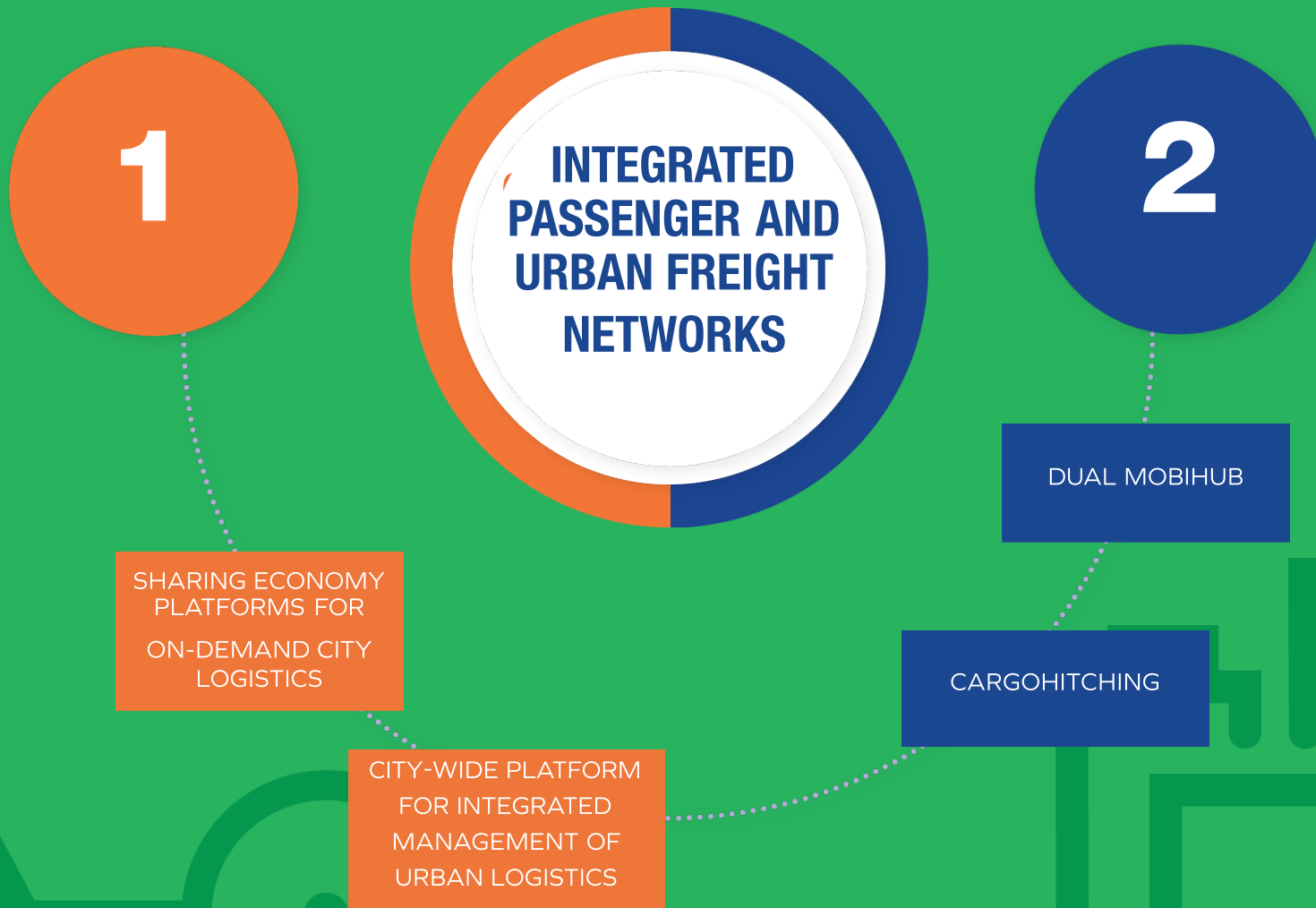


OUR VISION:

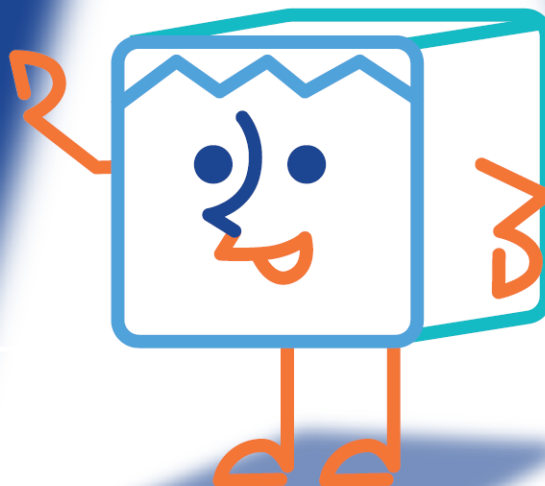
